Summer Learning Revolution: Inventure Academy & Arrowsmith Team Up

This year, Inventure Academy has partnered with the Arrowsmith Institute, Toronto and the Adhyan Charitable Trust to launch a first of its kind in India, the Arrowsmith- Cognitive Intensive Program for 6 weeks during summer. At Inventure Academy, Whitefield-Sarjapur, 24 students from Grades 4-8 are participating in the programme.

The Arrowsmith Program is based on neuroscientific research and the philosophy that it is possible to 'rewire' the brain and improve cognitive functioning through a series of cognitive exercises. The Cognitive Intensive Program (CIP) model is intended for anyone who would like to enhance the Symbol Relations cognitive function. Also called Clocks, this is a higher-order cognitive function.

While every child is different, studies show that the typical student experiences improvements in processing concepts across all academic disciplines, understanding and quickly grasping what they read and hear, logical reasoning, seeing connections between ideas, processing information, and making rational decisions.





The gains resulting from strengthening this function are lifelong to all aspects of learning. This resonates with Inventure's Definition of Learning

On April 18th, Inventure Academy conducted a one-day leadership workshop on Innovative Project Management for a select group of 30 faculty members. Led by Vihari Komaragiri, the day wasn't just about lectures, it was an action-packed training session, designed to equip the participants with skills to become confident and agile leaders in their spheres.

Through engaging games, the participants stepped outside their comfort zones, built connections with their peers, and learned to think on their feet - a crucial skill for any leader. This energizing start set the stage for a day of collaborative learning and growth.

Participants then tackled simulated project challenges, thinking of them as mini-quests. Through interactive roleplaying, they honed their communication skills, became decision- making ninjas, and learned to solve problems head-on, all in a safe and supportive environment.

By analyzing real-world scenarios, they also unlocked the secrets of effective communication and collaboration. Using systems diagramming techniques, the participants learned to transform complex projects into clear and easy-to-understand roadmaps. Throughout the day, there was a considerable amount of time spent on sharing experiences, exchanging ideas, and strategizing ways to use their newfound skills. It was a collaborative quest for knowledge, and everyone walked away better equipped to conquer any project, big or small.

This collaborative reflection process provided an invaluable opportunity for participants to consolidate their learning, exchange perspectives, and strategize actionable steps for personal and professional development.
