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NDTV - Battleground Karnataka

Our Co-Founder & Founding CEO, Nooraine Fazal along with TV Mohandas Pai (Chairman, Aarin Capital Partners), Sandeep Shastri (Academics, NITTE Education Trust and National Coordinator, Lokniti, TM Veera raghav (Executive Editor, NDTV), Shraddha Sharma (CEO, YourStory Media) and Sugata Srinivasaraju (Senior Journalist and Author) were on 29 March 2024 part of a panel discussion on NDTV. The discussion was on the forthcoming elections in Karnataka and the citizens' expectations.

The panel covered various issues related to the Karnataka's Lok Sabha and Vidhana Soudha elections. Nooraine spoke to some of our senior school students to get a better understanding of what youth wanted from the Government. Amongst some of the important issues she dwelled on, were the emphasis on the party that comes into power providing equality of opportunity, and being more true to the idea of unity in diversity. She also raised concerns about our city Bangalore being the 2nd largest contributor of taxes in India, but getting minimal return by way of investment in our social and physical infrastructure.

Below are what some of the students had to say, after they had watched the show and heard what Nooraine had to say, during the discussion.

"Nooraine ma'am brought in important needs of the people, both citywide and nationwide, largely in relation to the youth's need for education as well as the need for diversity and unity across the country. She picked up various inputs from younger people, creating a more well balanced viewpoint on the panel."

"Nooraine ma'am's interview perfectly represented the thoughts of the youth of India, in my opinion. Her politically neutral tone reflected that despite the diversity in the country, everyone looks towards development. "

Lego Learning Takes Centre Stage



The students at our Yeshwanthpur Campus, this term, learnt to develop fine-motor skills and problem-solving abilities using Lego kits. They also understood the basic form and application of Mechanical Advantage Systems such as pulleys, gears, wheels and axles. By creating, and working together on the projects, they learnt the advantages of collaboration and teamwork.

They began by agreeing on the general idea of a project which they chose, and then went on to build, learn and follow each other's leads and understand how different ideas contribute to the successful completion of a project. Grade 5 learners worked on their coding skills using EV3 kits. Mindstorm EV3 robotics is an excellent tool that develops their cognitive skills and their understanding of robotics.
