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Outbound Trip Bolsters Courage and Confidence



A total of 69 Grade 10 students from Whitefield Sarjapur were taken on an outbound trip to the picturesque Naukuchiatal hill station near Nainital in the Kumaon Hills, a giant leap from Bangalore's latitude of 13 North to Nainital's 30 North! The trip was organized in partnership with Youreka, with emphasis on building courage and decision-making skills.

Students learnt vital lessons on trust, respect and communication on the Friendship Ladder and overcame their latent fears and apprehensions. This was a teamwork activity where participants helped each other to climb up a ladder rigged up in a manner that required a graduated increase in the levels of effort and skill that were necessary to ascend. They went on to learn the skills of kayaking and had a great time on the lake. They also spotted quite a few varieties of fishes in the lake and along the more placid waters of the shore. For that rush of adrenaline, they were introduced to Tree Jumaring, an activity that infused self-awareness, concentration and confidence. This was an individual achievement activity where each participant learnt how to climb up a rope attached to a tree trunk. A night spent outdoors, under the stars, added to the spirit of adventure and novelty.





Youreka's team had creatively designed a line-up of engaging activities such as 'Book Your Day' and 'Minute to Win It', all conducted in a collaborative group setting. Divided into 4 groups (The Kartoosh Kitchen, Chidya Wood, The Mavericks and Mr Nags), students strategized and revelled in the spirit of camaraderie and healthy competition. Youreka's expert team ensured a safe and enriching environment, focussed on empowering students to gain confidence and independence.

Prior to the trip, both students and parents were taken through orientation sessions where they were comprehensively briefed on the trip's theme, goals and the attendant safety protocols, ensuring that everyone felt prepared and confident.
