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# Unleashing Creativity: Our Middle School 'Beyond Academics' Showcase at the Whitefield-Sarjapur Campus

The Middle School 'Beyond Academics' Showcase, Term I, was a culmination of the learning objectives of the different PODs that we offer students of Middle School for the 1st term. Detailed below are the highlights of the activities:





**Art:** The fundamentals of visual Grammar were reinforced as learners created individual artworks and group projects like portraits, figure drawings, clay sculpting, landscapes, still life studies and collages.

**Dance:** Students showcased hip-hop and contemporary dance styles while they learned the basics of choreography and musicality.

**Music:** Learners performed the song *Viva la Vida* by Coldplay as an ensemble. Through the intricate, rhythmic and harmonic interactions required to perform this pop rock piece, learners demonstrated effective collaboration and coordination.

**Theater**: Students displayed their learning through a performance which was scripted by them. They did the scene blocking using freeze frames.







**Yoga**: Students showcased *Hatha Yoga* while displaying how it helps create strength, flexibility, fluidity, control and more discipline in the body.

**Needlework & Embroidery**: Students showcased their learning of the fundamentals of hand embroidery, including transferring designs onto fabric, securing the hoop and mastering basic hand embroidery stitches to craft intricate patterns.

**Woodwork**: Students made a set of rocking horses for toddlers. They started by making a scaled down version, followed by a full scale one. They used a jigsaw, a drill and other hand tools.

**Chess**: Students displayed their learning through a demonstration of basic move notation comprehension, executing simple tactical manoeuvers such as captures, checks, and basic piece coordination. They learned to apply diverse tactical strategies and some of them attempted to master advanced tactical concepts and specific chess openings.

**Cooking**: Students showcased their learning journey by putting together a delectable spread of dishes for the audience.

**Book Club**: Students were introduced to various genres and showcased activities based on their creative skills such as poster making, review writing, weaving stories, graphics and composing poems. They also intend to publish their work in the Carpe Diem Chronicles or in this publication, at a later date.


**Pottery:** Students showcased their prowess on the potter's wheel and used 'underglazes' to design and decorate with colours and textures. It was a unique display of collaborative and team-based learning.

**Robotics:** Students created a six-legged walking robot, programmed to walk around a room without "bumping into obstacles".

**Improv comedy**: Students showcased their learning by displaying improv tools through storytelling by a performance within the realm of comedy.

Through PODS, the insistence on well-rounded education is taken a step further at Inventure Academy. The multi-age groupings helped learners work at their own pace and developmental needs. The focus was on developing and honing skills. During the showcase, students came up with their presentations and performances and took the audience through their learning journey for the Term.
