Onam Celebrations at our Schools: A Festive Tribute to Kerala's Heritage

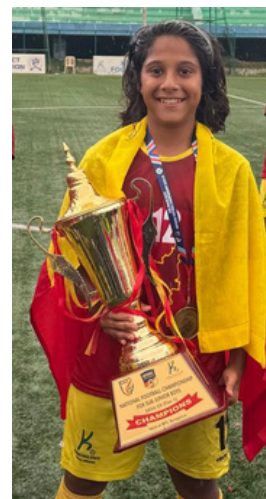
