Transforming wild dreams into real goals—proving that big ideas start with just one spark of imagination.

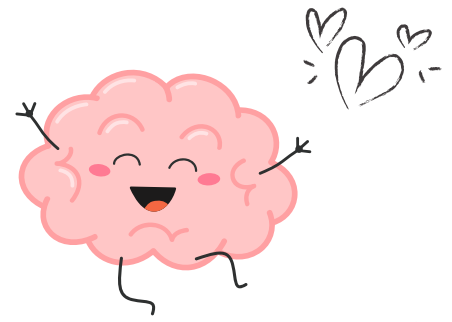
😬 Grade 3 – Oops to Aha!

The Inventure Impact Maker: Growing Young Changemakers



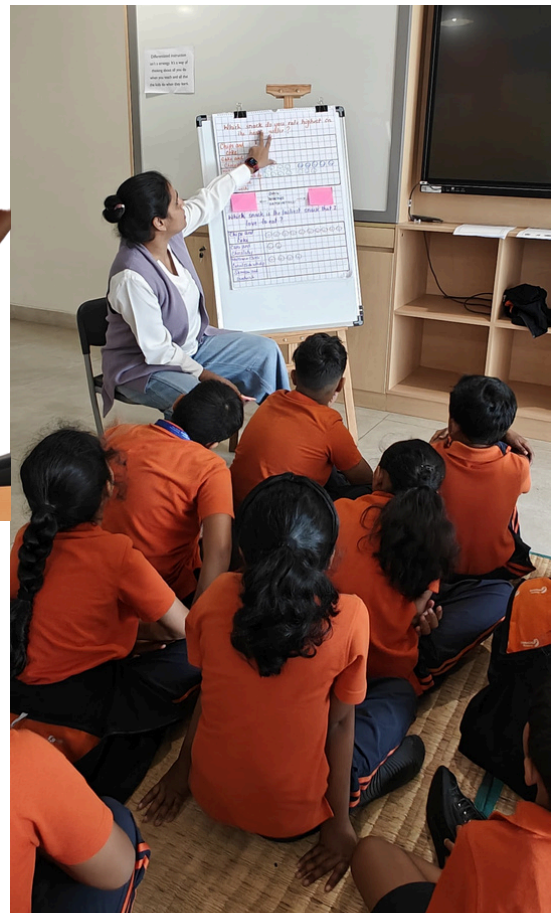
The *Inventure Impact Maker* is a flagship program at Inventure Academy, Yeshwanthpur, crafted to empower learners from Grades 2–5 with the knowledge, skills, and mindsets to think and act like entrepreneurs. More than just a lesson in business, the program reframes entrepreneurship as a way to make a meaningful difference - for people, for the planet, and yes, for profit too.

In the opening sessions, students dived into the concepts of a *growth mindset* and the importance of perseverance when tackling challenges. They honed their empathy and active listening skills - learning to truly understand the needs of others, a vital first step in designing solutions that matter.

Then came a moment of self-reflection. Turning their focus inward, learners began observing their own habits and routines, looking for everyday problems they might solve. One insight sparked a lively discussion: their snacking habits. They realised that their choices didn't always please their parents - or their bodies.

This sparked a deeper inquiry into food - its building blocks, its impact on health, and the delicate balance between nutrition and enjoyment. Through hands-on experiments, taste tests, and inspiring guest talks, students discovered that healthy snacks don't have to be boring, and tasty snacks don't have to be unhealthy. They began shaping an idea: snacks that are good for both the body and the taste buds.

With curiosity as their compass and creativity as their toolkit, these young innovators are already learning that making an impact starts with noticing the world around you - and daring to change it for the better.

She wasted no time proving them right. In the tournament opener against the Kalyani Bengaluru Blasters, Karnika top-scored for her side, claimed a crucial wicket, and pulled off a sharp catch - a performance that earned her the **Player of the Match** award. From that moment, she cemented her role as the Dragons' go-to all-rounder, blending batting power, bowling precision, and electric fielding.
