## YPR K2 learners shine at the 3rd Edition of Kalakriti



### A Celebration of Creativity, Exploration, and Young Artistic Confidence

The Art Studio at Inventure Academy, Yeshwanthpur Campus, came alive on 2nd December 2025 as our K2 learners participated in the much-awaited 3rd edition of *Kalakriti*. This annual art showcase beautifully captured the culmination of their learning in Visual Art, bringing together months of exploration, experimentation, and joyful discovery.



The atmosphere was vibrant as our young artists arrived eager and curious, ready to take on the creative challenge. True to the spirit of Kalakriti, the topic for the artwork was revealed on the spot, giving learners the opportunity to respond spontaneously—drawing upon the skills, techniques, and artistic understanding they have developed throughout the year.

Once the topic was announced, the children confidently selected their preferred mediums—from colour pencils and oil pastels to poster paints. As they began composing their artwork, it was heartwarming to see how thoughtfully they applied what they had learnt: balancing elements, choosing colours purposefully, experimenting with patterns, and using styles and influences from various folk art forms and artists they had studied.

Before the creation process began, the Art Team took learners through a quick visual recap of their lessons, helping them recall concepts in composition, technique, and storytelling through art. This allowed each child to approach their artwork with clarity, intention, and a sense of ownership.

The results were delightful. Each piece reflected individuality, imagination, and the growing artistic confidence of our K2 learners. Their artworks stood as a testament not only to their creativity but also to the thoughtful guidance of the Art Department, which nurtures artistic expression through exploration rather than instruction.

At the close of the session, each learner was awarded a badge and certificate—a small gesture to honour their participation, effort, and talent. The pride on their faces made the moment truly special. Selected artworks will be displayed during an upcoming school occasion, offering our broader community the chance to appreciate the budding artists' work.

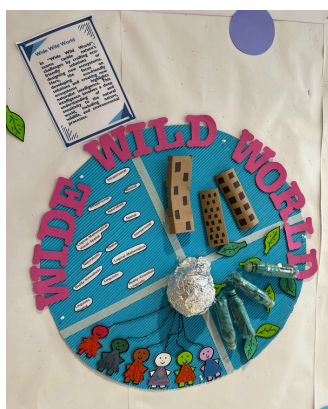
 **Wide Wild World** inspired participants to imagine eco-friendly ecosystems, seamlessly blending environmental awareness with design thinking and teamwork.

## The Young Entrepreneurs Challenge: Funds Raised for CareForAll

Our senior students from Grade 11 at the Sarjapur campus organised the **Young Entrepreneurs Challenge** during Sports Day and successfully generated a profit of **₹28,533**. This amount was directed towards **CareForAll**, supporting its social impact initiatives.

**CareForAll** was a youth-led non-profit organisation founded and run by **Pranoy Mathur**, a Grade 11 student of Inventure Academy. The organisation was managed entirely by a dedicated team of high-school students who oversaw all aspects of its operations, including fundraising, outreach, and social media engagement.

**CareForAll** was committed to serving underprivileged communities through healthcare access and awareness. It mobilised doctors from top-tier hospitals and collaborated with partner NGOs to conduct medical camps for children. Over the course of its journey, the organisation impacted **over 1,400 lives**, raised **more than ₹7 lakh**, and conducted **nine medical camps and awareness sessions**.

CareForAll received the profits generated from the student-run stalls at the **Annual Athletic Meet 2025**. Along with additional funds raised through other sources, the amount was utilised entirely to conduct **general health check-ups for students at Ramagondanahalli Government School**. The medical camps were planned for **December 2025**, with the exact dates subject to change.



## Outstanding Performance at the Mental Math World Cup 2025

The production was vibrant, layered, and playful—yet unmistakably thoughtful, in that very Inventure way.





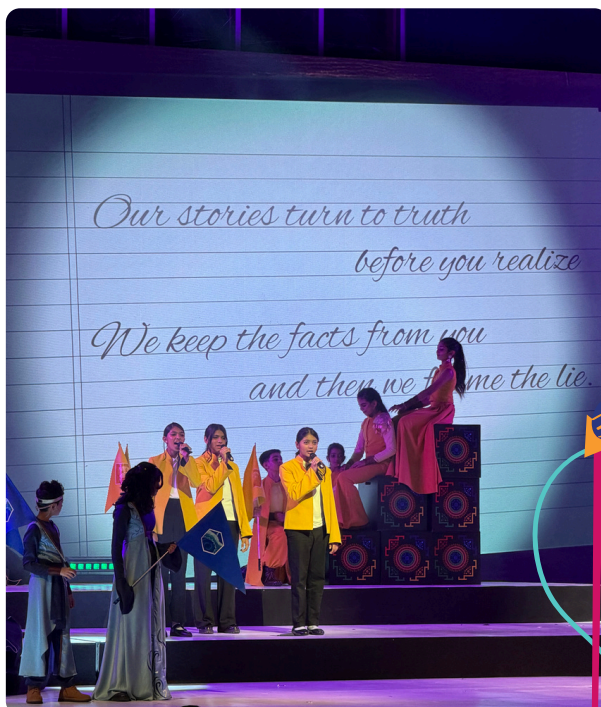
## Supporting a Cause That Truly Mattered
