## Our First Theme lesson: "All About Me" at Inventure Preschool

We at Inventure Preschool began our journey into **theme-based learning** with a meaningful and engaging topic: "All About Me". This theme is designed to help children embark on a journey of self-discovery—celebrating their individuality while learning to appreciate the uniqueness of others.

The topic was introduced through simple yet powerful conversations that asked, "What makes each of us unique?" These discussions laid the foundation for **self-awareness**, encouraging learners to reflect on their own qualities, strengths, and interests.

As part of this exploration:

- Learners drew **self-portraits** and creatively used a collection of different materials to represent themselves, allowing for personal expression through visual art and tactile play.
- They identified and illustrated traits that make them special—such as being **kind, independent**, or working towards **personal goals**—reinforcing the idea that who we are goes beyond how we look.
- Students also engaged in sensory-based activities to understand the **five senses**, deepening their connection with their physical selves.

Building on this understanding of self, we introduced the concept of **emotions**. Through the story "My Many Colored Days" by Dr. Seuss, learners were guided to identify and express a range of basic emotions: **happy, sad, mad, frustrated** (a blend of sad and mad), and **scared**. They used **colors** to illustrate their feelings, creating a visual language for emotional expression and empathy. This theme has not only helped children begin to recognize their own emotions, thoughts, and identities but has also fostered early social-emotional learning—paving the way for confident, compassionate learners.

Our commitment to this vision begins early.

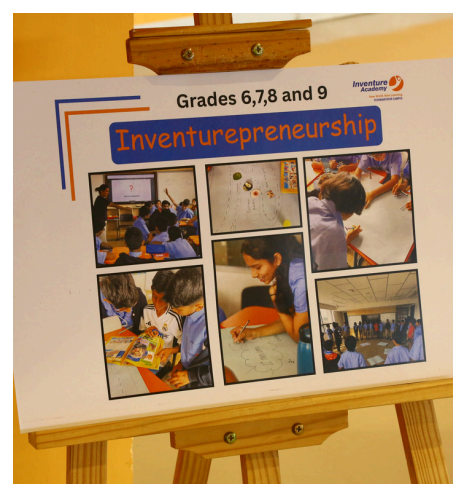

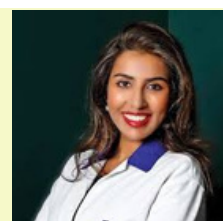
**Anuj Kacker** - Cofounder at Freo - India's first credit-led financial platform designed to help users pay, borrow, save, invest, and insure.

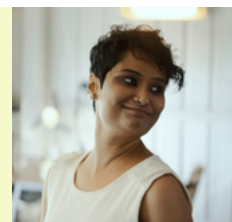

Congratulations, Vedant! Keep chasing greatness — we're cheering you on every step of the way!



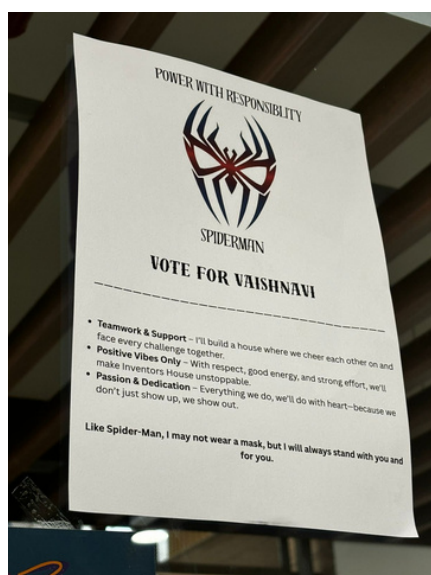
## Election Fever is Here!
