Students from our Yeshwanthpur campus embarked on an enriching outbound learning experience to **Kamshet, Maharashtra, from September 22–26, 2025**. Surrounded by the serene hills and lakes of Pune district, the program—facilitated by **INME (Youreka)**—was designed to help students learn through adventure, challenge, and collaboration.

The participants were grouped by grade:

1. **Inme Explorers** (Grades 4 & 5)
2. **Black Panthers** (Grades 6 & 7)
3. **Basmati Rice** (Grades 8 & 9)





During their stay in comfortable cottages amidst nature, students participated in a range of carefully curated activities such as **trekking, caving, raft building, jumaring, rappelling**, and the ever-popular **Mission Impossible** challenge. Each task encouraged them to step out of their comfort zones, communicate effectively, and work together to solve problems.

Evening **reflection circles** gave students the space to process their experiences—sharing what they learned about teamwork, courage, and self-awareness. Fun activities like **Campus Games, Minute to Win It**, and **Helter Skelter** added laughter, energy, and bonding to the days.

To ensure that students were fully immersed in the experience and develop independence, **there were no direct phone calls between parents and children** during the program. 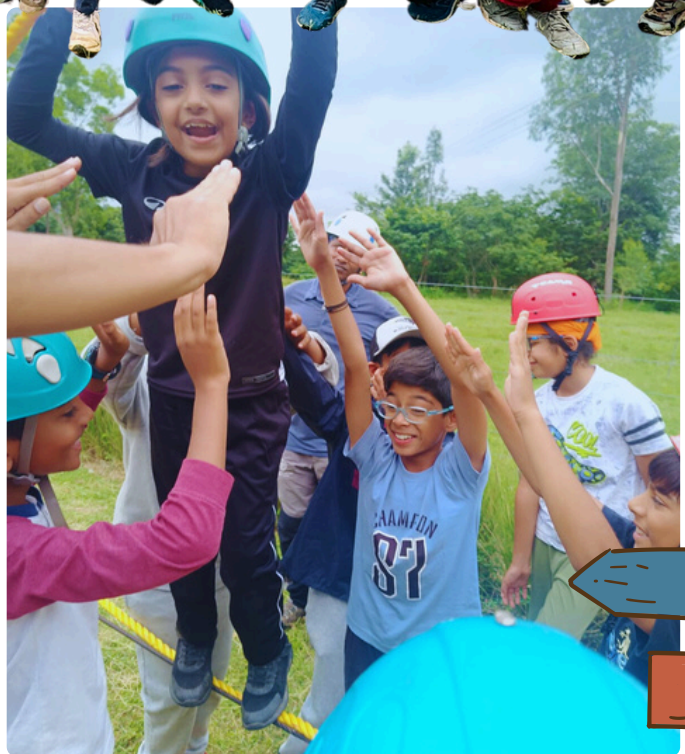
## Grade 4 – Skandagiri Outbound Learning Program: Learning Through Adventure
