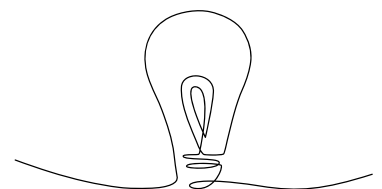
Their exploration extended into our own city. By studying the contrasts between old and new Bengaluru, students gained insight into rapid urban growth and the evolving connections between rural and urban spaces. A deep dive into the Yeshwanthpur community helped them identify key stakeholders and understand how each one shapes local development.





A powerful highlight of the programme was the visit to **Siddanahosahalli Government School (SSH)**. Students interacted with the principal, teachers and learners, attended the morning assembly, explored STEM labs and sports facilities and observed how dedicated stakeholders work together to build a nurturing learning environment. Inventure Academy was honoured to host Mr Irfan Razack, Co-Founder & Chairperson of Inventure Academy and Executive Chairman & Managing Director of Prestige Group, as the Chief Guest for this year's Inventurepreneurship Celebration of Learning (COL). The day celebrated ideas, innovation and impact — bringing together inspiring conversations, student showcases and thought-provoking discussions on how entrepreneurship can serve as a mission for community building and real-world change.



The event opened with an engaging fireside chat between Mr Irfan Razack and Vipul Rathore, Senior Advisor at Jetri. Panel Discussion

Theme: Entrepreneurship as a Mission – Finding the Right Problems to Build with Communities

The panel brought together a remarkable group of innovators and changemakers who are addressing some of society's most urgent challenges through entrepreneurial thinking and collaboration:

- Ashik S. V., CEO, *Panjurli Labs Pvt. Ltd.*, shared how his circular-economy start-up transforms captured carbon into eco-friendly materials for community schools—combining environmental innovation with social responsibility.
- Gowthaman Desingh, Co-Founder, *BOSON White Water*, discussed creating decentralised water-management systems that enable communities to achieve water self-sufficiency.
- Dr H.S. Nagaraja, Founder & Chief Mentor, *Prayoga*, spoke about how providing access to advanced research facilities can spark curiosity and scientific exploration among young learners.
- Aagam Shah, Community Builder & Ex-Sattva, emphasised the need for strong partnerships between citizens, governments, and organisations to achieve sustainable social transformation.

The discussion reinforced a powerful idea — that entrepreneurship is not just about innovation or profit. It is about identifying the right problems and building solutions *with* communities, not *for* them.
