Our Mobility Our Voice: Rising Above The Gridlock By Lasya Mohan Varma



We have been running **Our Mobility Our Voice** for the past year, a student-run initiative with the aim of improving the safety, speed, and sustainability of daily commute for the school community. When we started working towards addressing this issue, we discovered **one factor that is a primary cause of both traffic congestion and incredibly unsafe journeys: potholes.**

With the aim of ultimately fixing these gaping craters on our roads, we conducted a pothole survey on Varthur-Sarjapur Road, finding a whopping **139 potholes in just 650 meters!** Our work was recognized by the **Times of India**, who published our key findings. We analysed the data we collected, classifying the several potholes we found into different severity levels and calculating the decrease in speed caused by the potholes in each 50-meter stretch. We also developed Google Maps, heatmaps and elevated 3-D maps to visually depict our survey findings and make them accessible to everyone.

Reap Benefit, one of the largest organisations in India working with the youth, invited us to share our story at their Changemaker Adda.

Since the beginning of the new Academic Year (2025-26), a plethora of traffic issues have cropped up. The heavy rains in May led to severe waterlogging and congestion, resulting in students arriving late to their exams. Even now, the monsoon remains unforgiving, causing massive delays in students' daily commutes. In response to this, we released a petition urging the Government to improve drainage systems in key school zones and ensure school roads are accessible during heavy rains as well. **With nearly 500 signatures, our petition is growing!**



In August, there was also a surge in congestion levels, with students reaching home hours after they usually do. Collaborating with the Baghirathi Team, we analysed data from several school buses across schools on State Highway 35 and discovered that students spend an average of 3 hours on the road every day! We presented our findings to the Joint Commissioner of Police (Traffic) Karthik Reddy and his team. They responded positively to our ideas and are ready to collaborate with us to tackle traffic together!

Simultaneously, we started a new series on our social media, titled VoicesInJam, which showcases perspectives from students, teachers, and parents on the traffic issue. **With videos in this series collectively reaching almost 1000,000 (1 crore) views, the Government and the residents of Bangalore have started to prioritise our voices.** Our voices have been featured across newspapers like Deccan Herald, Times of India, India Today, etc.

NDTV also recently shot a video of several Inventure students riding on the bus. They interviewed our CEO, Nooraine Fazal, about insights from the report and her take on the traffic situation. They spoke to Lasya Mohan Varma about why she started the campaign and the key issues she's noticed as she led this initiative. They gave numerous Inventure students on the bus an opportunity to voice their concerns about the traffic situation and the direct impact it has had on them.

In this entire endeavour, we were elated to witness our students speaking up for themselves and presenting a collective voice that has now captured the Government of Karnataka's attention! As Nooraine Ma'am told us (rephrased), "Democracy is about more than just voting for someone. You have the power to participate in the democratic process by speaking up for what you believe in and raising your voice for causes that matter to you. Your voice is valuable."

Throughout this journey, we have collaborated with and been supported by numerous civic organisations, including Whitefield Rising and the Bangalore Political Action Committee. They have helped us amplify our voices and reach a much larger audience than we could have imagined. Our team at Inventure Academy is also growing, with juniors joining the group and numerous teachers starting to contribute to this cause.



We hope that we can initiate a stronger collaboration with the Government of Karnataka and the Greater Bengaluru Authority now. We'd like to work together to solve traffic for students across Bengaluru, so that those who will inherit this city in the future aren't forced to lose their childhoods to gridlocks.

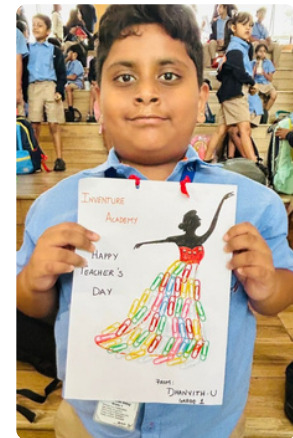


Celebrating Teachers' Day at Inventure Academy

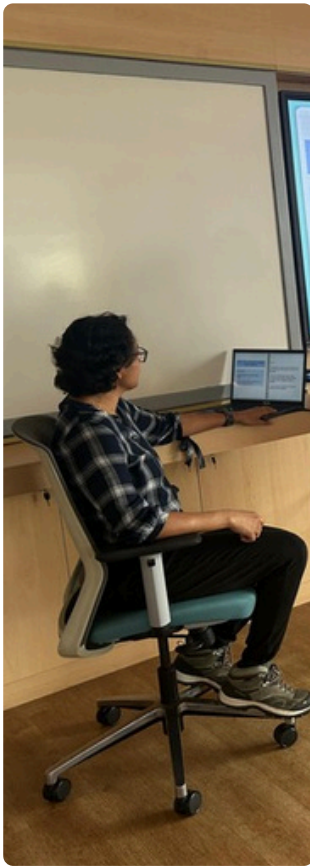

The Writing Workshop & Publishing

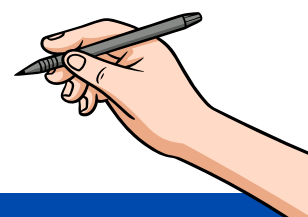

Nature Walk with ARRC – Discovering Birds and Tiny Creatures

Inventure's lush campus at Sarjapur is not just a place for learning - it's also a thriving habitat for a wide variety of trees, plants, and countless feathered visitors. As part of our From Me to We program, Grade 2 students embarked on a guided Nature Walk with experts from ARRC. With keen eyes and curious minds, they learned to slow down, observe carefully, and discover the hidden wonders of biodiversity that surround them every day.

This experience encouraged students to look beyond the obvious, to listen for birdsong, notice rustling leaves, and spot the small yet significant creatures that make up the delicate web of life on campus.

By the end of this session, students:



- Practised birdwatching with guidance from an expert.
- Explored how birders observe and identify birds in their natural habitats.
- Developed a deeper awareness of their environment, noticing not just birds but also insects, plants, and other natural details.

The **From Me to We** program is designed to nurture empathy, responsibility, and connectedness. It encourages learners to shift their perspective from the individual to the collective - to recognize that their actions, choices, and awareness contribute to the well-being of the community and the planet. This walk is one way to build that bridge, showing students how their relationship with nature is part of a larger whole.

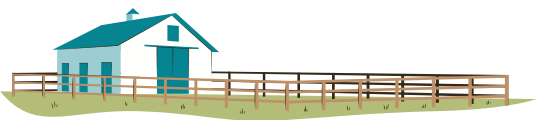

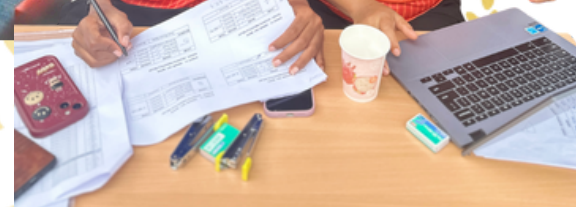

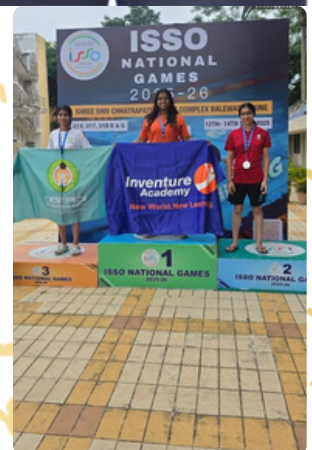
